Teen Lodge Guidelines and Information

LOCATION: The Charter, 120 Offerson Rd.; PO Box 5310; Beaver Creek 81620, 970.949.6660. All students will be housed 2 per room in separate beds. View photos of The Charter at www.thecharter.com. The Charter has an indoor twenty meter lap pool, outdoor pool, indoor and outdoor hot tubs, steam rooms, saunas plus fully equipped locker rooms.

CHECK IN:

CSI students for session 1: Monday, June 9, 2:00 PM until 3:00 PM

CRoc students Monday, June 9, 2:00 PM until 3:00 PM

CSI students for session 2: Monday, June 16, 2:00 PM until 3:00 PM

One of the teen counselors will meet you in the lobby of The Charter. At check-in, each student will inspect the condition of the room along with a Teen Lodge counselor.

Be sure to arrange your travel so that you arrive at The Charter between 2 and 3 pm. If this is not possible due to airlines schedules, contact the institute office to arrange arrival on Sunday.

CRoc students: Sunday, June 22, 9 AM until 10:00 AM

You can place your luggage in your counselors' rooms until after the concerts are over if needed. At check out, each student will inspect the condition of the room along with a CSI\CRoc counselor and The Charter staff. Any damages incurred during the student's stay will be the responsibility of the students.

GUIDELINES FOR TEEN LODGE RESIDENTS

THE FOLLOWING WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE PARENTAL NOTIFICATION REGARDING DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND POSSIBLE DISMISSAL:

1. *Boys in girls' sleeping rooms;*
2. *Girls in boys' sleeping rooms;*
3. *Smoking;*
4. *Use of illegal drugs or substances;*
5. *Illicit or wrongful use of legal drugs or substances;*
6. *Violation of curfew;*
7. *Leaving Beaver Creek Resort without a counselor;*
8. *Disruptive behavior;*
9. *Absences from class/truancy.*

The Director of Music of the Colorado Institute of Music shall have complete discretion as to any dismissal of a student from the Institute. In the event of any such dismissal, the student's parent or legal guardian understands and agrees that they shall be responsible for any and all costs required to transport the student back to his or her legal address. They further understand and agree that a student's dismissal from the Institute shall constitute a forfeiture of all tuition, costs, and registration fees paid.
